MONTHLY ACTIVITIES REPORT
FEBRUARY 2018**

A: ACTIVITIES COMPLETED

1. Two samples were taken for coliform testing. Both samples were absent. Monthly backwash data was taken and the monthly report sent to the Watershed Management Division. The monthly Water Operations report was sent to the Water and Groundwater Protection Division
2. Champlin Associates reprogrammed the Wet Well VFD's to solve the drop out problem.

3. The new SC1000 screen was replaced on the raw and finished water chlorine/ph monitor.
4. The media depths in the six Kinetico filters were checked. No new media was added.
5. The meter was replaced at 1 Drawbridge Lane after the original meter failed.
6. A water allocation was granted for 35 Faywood Rd. The allocation is for 450gpd.
7. Required sampling for SOC's, VOC's, IOC's, Cyanide and TSS was completed. Results have not been received yet.

B. ACTIVITIES IN PROGRESS

1. LT-2 raw water samples are being submitted every two weeks.
2. We have met with the owners and contractor who will be doing the work at 122 Allen Road and they have agreed to the Boards conditions for connecting to the system.. The work will be done as soon as permits are in place and the weather co-operates.
3. Seasonal meters that are stored in the water plant are being checked for accuracy.
4. The updated Source Protection Plan has been completed and sent to the State for approval.

C. ACTIVITIES PLANNED OR NEEDED.

1. The antenna for the Lover's Lane to Plant communication system is to be raised from the Bell Hill building to the power pole.
2. V-Trans has requested that we wait until spring to continue with valve repairs. (Weather related)
3. Media levels in the Kinetico filters will be checked.
4. Meters will be read during the week of March 12-16th.

D. BILLINGS AND COLLECTIONS

1. Accounts receivable as of March 8 is \$17,329.13
2. On February 16th 42 disconnect notices were sent out. On March 6th six 24 hour notices were posted on doors. All called and either paid or made payment arrangements.
3. One lien was placed on one account in February. Currently there are six liens on delinquent accounts.
4. One check was returned in February for non-sufficient funds.
